Introducing Girl Friends Fund Board of Directors 2021-2022

The Girl Friends Fund, Inc. ("The Fund") Board is composed of 15 GFF members and/or their spouses who volunteer their time and talent to function as administrators. In addition, the Board provides leadership in the areas of fund raising and marketing.

The Fund was conceived with the need to limit Board expenses in order to maximize scholarship awards and other charitable giving. To that end, The Fund Bylaws include a provision that no Board member may be compensated or otherwise reimbursed for her service. Additionally, there is no allowance for paid staff. This allows a maximum amount of donations to directly benefit our students.

Many committees of the Board are comprised of Fund members, all of whom volunteer their time and talent in the areas of law, marketing, information technology, financial services/accounting and creative writing.

The Girl Friends Fund welcomes five new directors to the Board. They are Lynnette Crenshaw-Cleveland Chapter; Faith Hairston-Toledo Chapter; Emily Monago-Toledo Chapter; Cheryl Smith-Orlando Chapter and Lashell Vaughn-Memphis Chapter. Each of these Girl Friends bring unique skills and talents to the Fund. All of them are eager to help "fuel the future" by raising funds to Bringing Dreams to Life.


